But the snow went away, and the sun made a nice cap for the birdhouse.

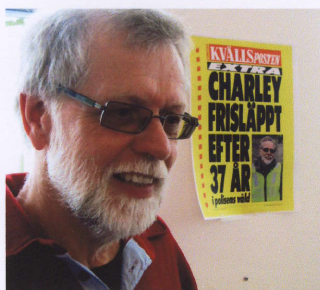


A few days in Vienna by Easter meant a lot to see and listen to.

Two weeks later Nellie congratulated her mother and grandmother to a well-executed fitness race.

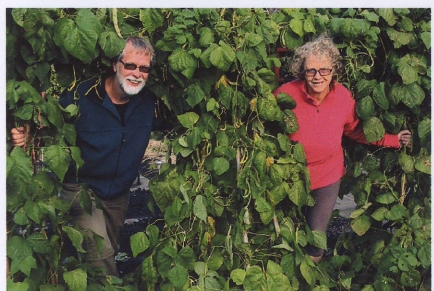
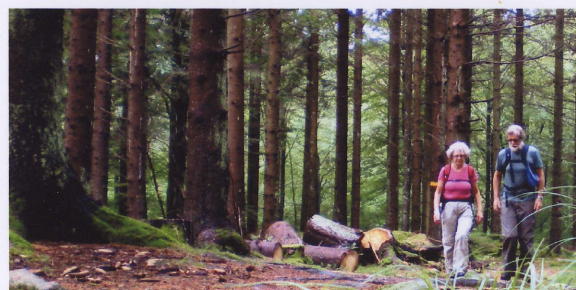


Spring also brought plants and animals back to life in our garden.



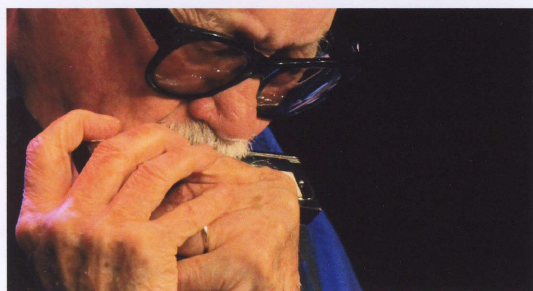
On June 1 Charley retired after 37 years as photographer and (for the last 17 years) information officer for the Police.
