Auschwitz

Auschwitz var det största av Nazitysklands koncentrations- och förintelsläger. Auschwitz är det tyska namnet på Oświęcim, en stad ca 60 kilometer väster om Kraków.

Auschwitz bestod av Auschwitz–I, det ursprungliga koncentrationslägret och administrativt centrum; Auschwitz II–Birkenau, koncentrations- och förintelsläger; samt Auschwitz III–Monowitz, arbetsläger.

Åren 1940–1945 deporterades 1,3 miljoner personer till Auschwitz, varav 1,1 miljoner dog i lägret. Nittio procent av dem var judar, de flesta mördades i gaskamrarna. De övriga var polacker, romer, sovjetiska krigsfångar och personer av annan nationalitet, liksom homosexuella.

AUSCHWITZ WAS THE LARGEST NAZI GERMAN CONCENTRATION CAMP AND DEATH CAMP.

IN THE YEARS 1940-1945, THE NAZIS DEPORTED AT LEAST 1,300,000 PEOPLE TO AUSCHWITZ:

**1,100,000 JEWS,
140,000-150,000 POLES,
23,000 ROMA (GYPSIES),
15,000 SOVIET PRISONERS OF WAR,
25,000 PRISONERS FROM OTHER ETHNIC GROUPS.**

1,100,000 OF THESE PEOPLE DIED IN AUSCHWITZ. APPROXIMATELY 90% OF THE VICTIMS WERE JEWS. THE SS MURDERED THE MAJORITY OF THEM IN THE GAS CHAMBERS.

Block 11 was known as the "Death Block". It served several functions, of which the most important was its role as the central camp jail. Male and female prisoners from all parts of the camp complex were held in this building. Most of these people were suspected by the camp Gestapo of involvement in clandestine activities: attempting to escape, organizing mutinies, and maintaining contacts with the outside world.

Poles from outside the camp who had been arrested for rendering aid to prisoners were imprisoned here too. Following brutal interrogations, they were in most cases sentenced to death by shooting. In the early years of the camp the Strafkompagnie (penal unit) and Erziehungskompagnie (re-education unit) were also held in this block. The prisoners of the penal unit, to which almost all the Jewish men and Polish priests held in the camp at that time were sent on arrival, were assigned to the most back-breaking work; most of them died.

For some time the block also held the Sonderkommando, the special unit of prisoners employed to burn the bodies of the dead.

From 1943 on, Polizeihäftlinge (police detainees) were also held here. These were Poles from the area under the jurisdiction of the Gestapo in Katowice who were suspected of involvement in the resistance movement. They would be held here awaiting sentence from a special German summary court. Usually the penalty was death.

In the basement, known as the bunker, were punishment cells where the SS confined prisoners regarded as guilty of violating camp regulations. In 1941 prisoners sentenced to death by starvation were held here.

Over the period 3-5 September 1941, the SS carried out experiment in the basement with Zyklon B in preparation for the mass murder of Jews: 600 Soviet POWs and 250 Polish political prisoners, selected from the camp infirmary as human guinea-pigs for this experiment, were murdered here in this way.
